Dental Trauma	Limit:	Individual treatment/benefit levels, subject to an overall limit of £10,000 per injury incident.	
Emergency Callout	Up to:	£135 to £200 Weekdays - 6am to 8am / 6pm to 10pm - £135 Weekdays/Weekends - 10pm to 6am - £200 Weekends & Bank Holidays - 6am to 10pm - £180	
Emergency Temporary Treatment - UK	Up to:	Individual treatment/benefit levels, subject to a maximum of £460 per incident and £920 in any 12 month period.	
Emergency Temporary Treatment - Abroad	Up to:	£460 (inclusive of emergency treatment and callout fees).	
Hospitalisation as a result of dental trauma		£50 per day after the first day - maximum 365 days	
Facial Scarring benefit as a result of dental trauma	£50-£500	up to 5 cm 5 cm - 7.5 cm over 7.5 cm	£50 £100 £500
Redundancy Protection	Plan premiums paid for up to one year, maximum £15 per month for a single plan, or £60 per month for multiple plans on behalf of dependants, with a waiting period of 30 days. Patients must have been employed for a minimum of six months if the request is within the first six months of joining the plan. Does not apply to fixed-term contracts, self-employed patients, registration plans or company schemes.		
Oral Cancer upon diagnosis	£2,500 (effective after first 90 days of joining the plan)		

Submitting a request for assistance should be done as soon as possible, but in any event, within 60 days of dental trauma, emergency callout or redundancy. Note - please refer to the Scheme Handbook for the full Scheme Rules, including exclusions, limits and excesses.

It is important that, if at all possible, you contact us before going ahead with treatment as we may not pay requests for assistance that have not been pre-authorised.
